To celebrate **International Women's Day** in collaboration with PARA-WAGE, Ravulapalem to celebrate women's achievements throughout history and across nations.









Resolutions:

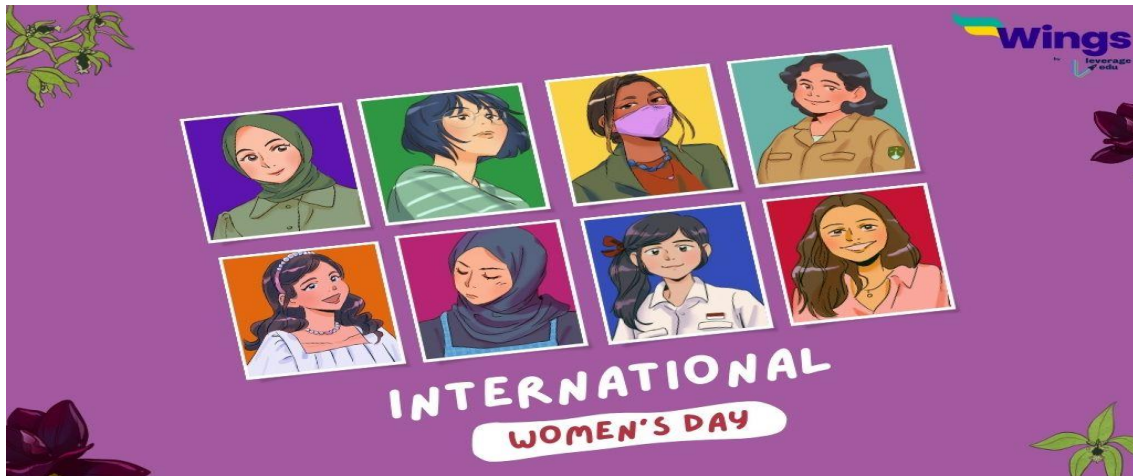


